HOURS:

JOB DESCRIPTION:

- Must have required certification to perform NDT analysis out in the field
- Climb a minimum of one to three wind turbine towers daily for thorough analysis
- Wind Turbine towers can be up to 320' in height
- Ability to use the following equipment: Phased Array, Olympus Omniscan MX & Ultrasonic flaw detector
- Conduct daily reports including photo documentation daily for every tower and submit them daily to corporate
- Requires safe assessment of all work, equipment and safe performance daily
- On-site inspections with detailed reporting up tower, outside of tower, or on the ground
- Capability to work in confined spaces and height of over 320'
- Will be required to work safely at all times, follow site supervisor safety protocols and bring safety gear to every job-site for work ranging from 2 weeks in duration up to 6 months
- Work as a member of a field group to support our customers
- Required to work with specialized safety and climbing equipment provided by the company
- Can work in severe weather ranging from really cold, hot and windy conditions
- Ability to work in confined spaces, thin spaces and small round spaces
- Ability to make safe and rational decisions under adverse circumstances
- Responsible for taking your own safety/climbing equipment to every job-site and maintaining a daily safety log
- Responsible for verifying and checking the proper and safe functioning of your equipment daily
- Perform miscellaneous duties, tasks & projects as needed

- Level II certification from SNT-TC-1A or ISO 9712, International Organization for Standards, Nondestructive testing -- Qualification and certification of personnel

- Strong computer skills to conduct complex field reports daily
- Ability to work autonomously with little supervision at times
- Valid driver's license (Passport preferred)
- Background check, drug screen, and DMV check
- Experience with power tools
- Ability to travel nationwide for two (2) weeks to four (4) months at a time
- Ability to work safely up to 320' off the ground and lift over 80lbs.
- Must have excellent customer service skills, work ethic, and integrity
